**Winter 2009 AARGS Habitat Project
Aspen Regeneration Site at DNR-Rose Lake Station, East Lansing**

Dates: Saturday, January 31 and Saturday, February 28, 2009

Location and Directions: DNR-Rose Lake Wildlife Area: Bath Rd. between Woodbury Rd. & Peacock Rd. Take Old M-78 to the east and exit at Woodbury Rd. heading north. Turn left on Bath Rd.; just a short distance, turn in to a marked parking area on the south side. AARGS members will be on hand there to assist in parking.

Time: 9:00 am--The project will involve removal of only shrubs and small trees to 3" diameter and stacking them.

--Chain saws (must be at least 18yrs.), pruning saws, loppers, and bow saws can all be used.

--The site to be cleared has been considerably expanded.

--Late arrivals follow the two-track through the open gate, past parked vehicles; on to the shuttle parking area.

Lunch: About 12:00-12:30 - a warm meal, dessert and drinks will be provided.
A brief educational talk on the habitat work will be presented.
