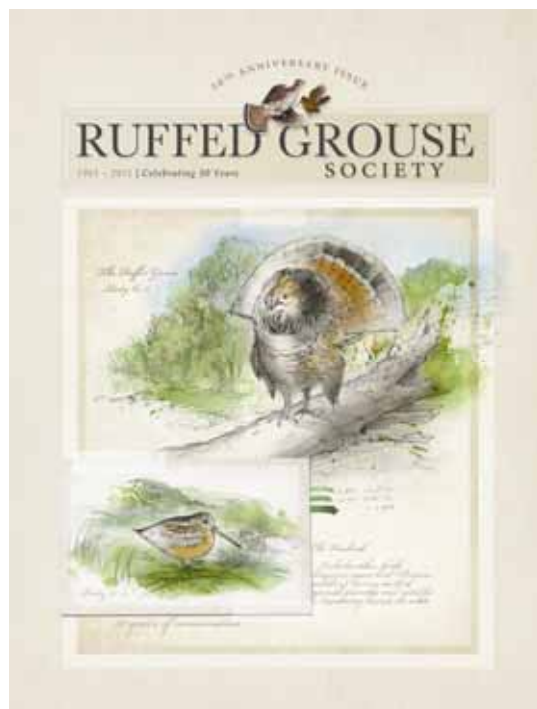

Arriving at Glendorn



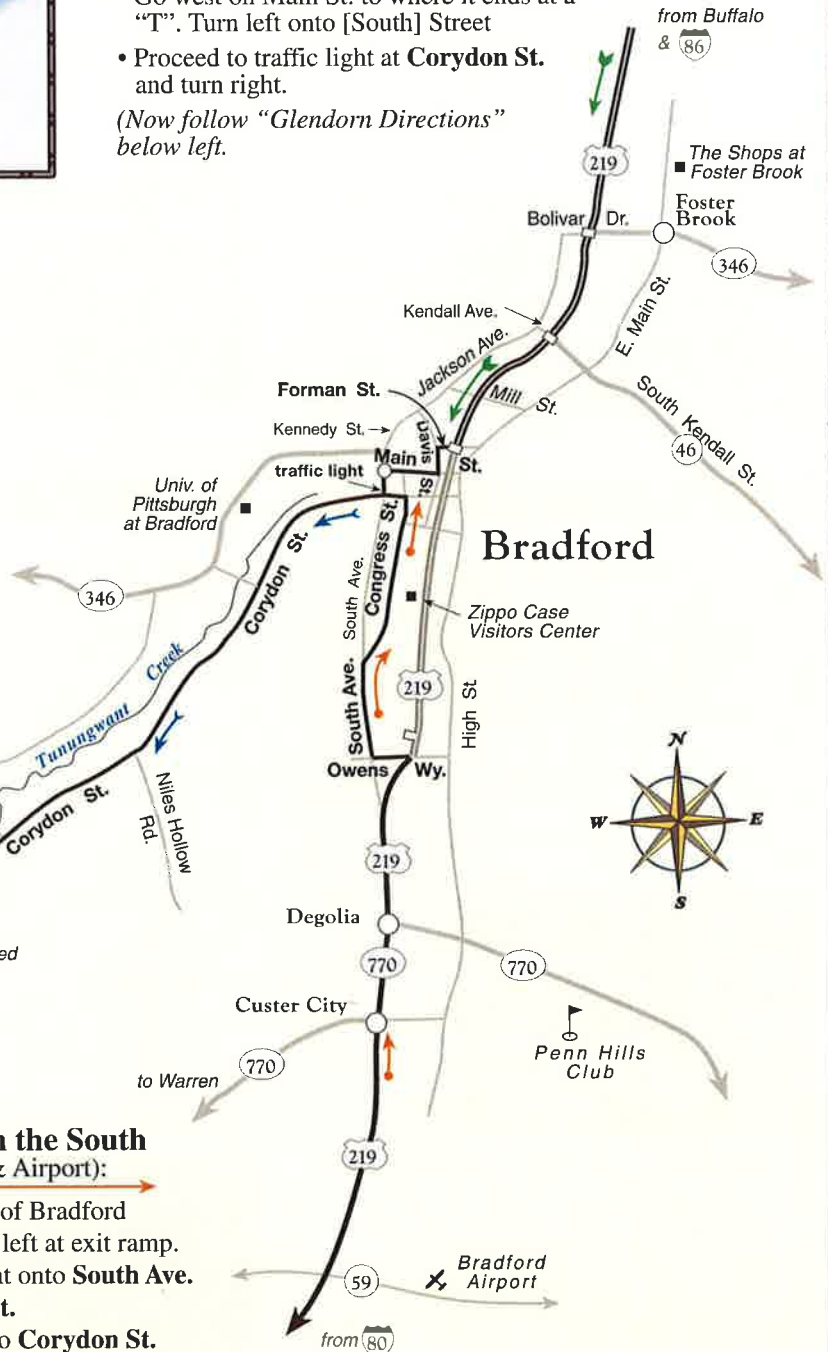
Entering Bradford from the North (from Buffalo, Toronto, I-86/ Rte.17):

- Take **U.S. 219** south to Bradford
- Take the **Forman St. exit** and turn right on **Forman St.**
- At the stop sign, turn left onto **Davis St.**
- Proceed two blocks to the traffic light at **Main St.** and turn right
- Go west on **Main St.** to where it ends at a "T". Turn left onto [South] Street
- Proceed to traffic light at **Corydon St.** and turn right.

(Now follow "Glendorn Directions" below left.)

Glendorn Directions

- From the **South St./Corydon St. traffic light** in Bradford, drive west on **West Corydon St.**
- At 4.3 miles, turn right at the **Glendorn sign** (watch for a **small red barn**).
- After passing several small houses and crossing a bridge, you arrive at the **Glendorn gates**.
- Stop at **gate keypad post** on driver's side (20 yards before gate). Follow instructions on keypad to open gates. (Gates will close automatically after you pass through.)
- Proceed 1.25 miles on **Glendorn Drive** to the **Big House and Office**. Park in the **small parking lot** just behind the Big House.



Entering Bradford from the South (from U.S. 6, Rte. 153, I-80 & Airport):

- Follow **U.S. 219** to outskirts of Bradford
 - Take **Owens Way exit**. Turn left at exit ramp.
 - At first intersection, turn right onto **South Ave.**
 - Angle right onto **Congress St.**
 - Turn left at the **stop sign** onto **Corydon St.**
- Now follow "Glendorn Directions" above left.
